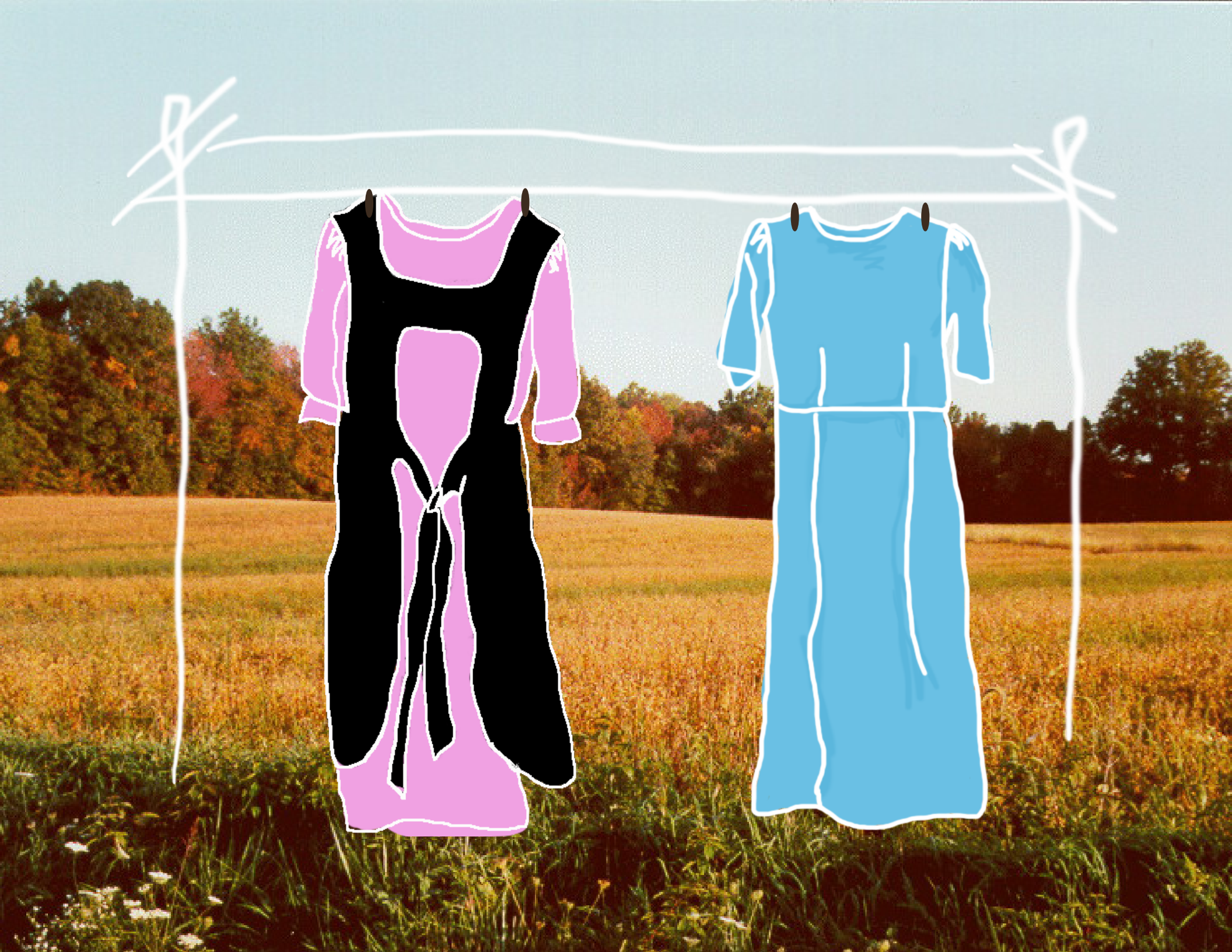

# clothing as armour

looking at traditions in the Amish community, the design of the project mimics an Amish child's play with dried corn kernels on the ground, in which the kernels are pushed, moved and shaped

with the use of AR, looking through a phone allows the user to reveal what is often difficult to see or find; ticks crawling on you. The goal was to switch the role of the user from an English person to an Amish person and to make visible what is usually invisible.
